

Diabetic Foot Screening Workshop, 19 Oct 2024

Using NICE guidelines as a framework, this workshop aims to equip you with the knowledge and skills to competently examine and screen the diabetic foot for potential and actual problems. It's not just the theory! In an interactive and safe learning environment, you will be putting your new knowledge into practice.

(1) Know what we are screening for, why and when.

(2) Identify the risk factors leading to foot ulcers/problems.

 Be familiar with national and loca lgorithms used to calculate the risk.

(4) Identify suitable and unsuitable footwear for people with diabetes.

(5) Know what contributes to peripheral arterial disease (PAD).

(6) Name the two arteries in the foot that are assessed as part of the screening process and be able to competen palpate them. (7) Know what contributes to <u>diabetic</u> peripheral neuropathy.

(8) Be able to competently use a 10g monofilament and undertake the Ipswich Touch Test (ITT) for neuropathy.

> (9) Give an appropriate risk classification according to findings from the examination, accurately document and take appropriate action depending on level of risk.
